Thando : "Art. That's why today, I'm very happy because I have art and I like it very much ! What about you Tom ?"

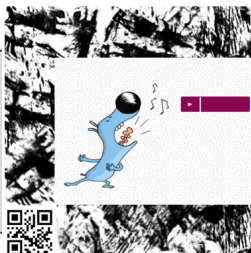

- You're more than welcome ! Speak to you very soon !

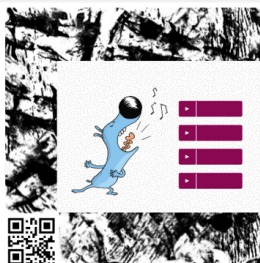

### CIVILISATION
